MINUTES

The regular meeting of the Upshur County Emergency Services District No. 1 Board of Commissioners was held on August 14, 2023, in the Upshur County Courtroom, Upshur County Courthouse, 150 E. Jefferson Street, Gilmer, Texas.

The District considered and acted upon the following matters:

- 1) Open meeting. The meeting was opened at 7:00 p.m. by Michael Kuza.
- 2) Call meeting to order, Roll Call of Board and establish quorum. Michael Kuza called the meeting to order. Michael Kuza determined a quorum with Michael Kuza, Scott Mischnick, Kenny Southwell and Cloddie Henson being present. Bobby Jenkins arrived at 7:13 p.m.
- 3) Public comment. None
- 4) Consider and take action on approval of:
 - A. The minutes of the previous meetings;
 - B. Accounts payable.

Kenny Southwell made a motion with a second by Scott Mischnick to approve the minutes of July 10, 2023 and July 31, 2023 as written. Motion carried 4-0. Unanimous vote in favor.

Kenny Southwell made a motion with a second by Cloddie Henson to pay the following bills:

Motion carried 4-0. Unanimous vote in favor.

- 5) <u>Discuss and take action regarding insurance costs and ways to reduce costs</u>. Discussion combined with item 8).
- 8) <u>Discuss and take action to start the process of liquidating older fire apparatus.</u>
 Michael Kuza had obtained a list of the vehicles that ESD #1 has insured with VFIS. The departments need to look over the list to help determine where some of these vehicles are located. Bobby Jenkins made a motion with a second by Cloddie Henson to authorize

Michael Kuza to contact Auctioneer Express to see what they could do with the Lafrance and ladder trucks. Motion carried 5-0. Unanimous vote in favor.

- 6) <u>Discuss and take action regarding a policy for alcohol in reference to insurance.</u>
 Discussion only. Michael Kuza encouraged the departments to add an alcohol policy to their by-laws.
- 7) <u>Discuss and take action regarding the repairs and re-purposing the engine from Glenwood to Ewell.</u> Kenny Southwell made a motion with a second by Cloddie Henson to have the older engine from the Glenwood station checked out and move to the Lafayette or Ewell station. Motion carried with 2 for and 3 abstained.
- 9) <u>Discuss and take action regarding property, equipment, and liens at Glenwood station</u>. Pass to next meeting.
- 10) Discuss and take action for purchasing burn ban banners for the county fire departments.

 No action.
- 11) Discuss and take action regarding the nomination of a Director to the Board of Directors
 of the Upshur County Appraisal District. Motion by Bobby Jenkins with a second by Kenny
 Southwell to nominate the current directors who are Brandon Dodd, Mike Spencer, Richard
 Gage, David Fontenot, and John Ussery. Motion carried 5-0. Unanimous vote in favor.
- **Discuss and take action regarding payment for the voice recorder located at the Gilmer Fire Station**. Chief Taylor presented an invoice to the Board from Commercial Electronics in the amount of \$1,350.00 as the annual maintenance fee for the voice recorder located at the Gilmer Fire Station. Motion by Kenny Southwell with a second by Cloddie Henson to pay the amount of \$337.50 as ¼ of the total amount upon receipt of invoice. Motion carried 5-0. Unanimous vote in favor.
- 13) Budget Discussion. No action.
- **14)** Discuss and take action to set the proposed tax rate by record vote. Motion by Scott Mischnick with a second by Cloddie Henson to set the proposed tax rate at .0700 per \$100 valuation. Votes:

- Discuss and take action to pay bills for Bettie VFD as submitted and approved. Motion by Bobby Jenkins with a second by Cloddie Henson to pay Bettie VFD bills in the amount of \$1,242.77. Motion by Kenny Southwell with a second by Bobby Jenkins to pay Bettie VFD in the amount of \$1,242.77 with the overage to be an advance on next year's budget. Motion carried 4-0 with Michael Kuza abstaining.
- 17) <u>Discuss and take action to pay bills for East Mountain VFD (station #1 and station #2) as submitted and approved</u>. Motion by Kenny Southwell with a second by Scott Mischnick to pay East Mountain VFD bills as submitted in the amount of \$2,109.50 for Station #1 and \$15.86 for Station #2. Motion carried 5-0. Unanimous vote in favor.
- **18)** Discuss and take action to pay bills for Ewell VFD as submitted and approved. Motion by Kenny Southwell with a second by Cloddie Henson to pay Ewell VFD bills in the amount of \$1,697.16. Motion carried 5-0. Unanimous vote in favor.
- **19)** Discuss and take action to pay bills for Harmony VFD as submitted and approved. Not paid as bills were submitted late.
- 20) <u>Discuss and take action to pay bills for Pleasant Grove VFD as submitted and approved</u>. Motion by Cloddie Henson and second by Bobby Jenkins to pay Pleasant Grove VFD bills in the amount of \$2,561.70. Motion carried 4-0 with Scott Mischnick abstaining.
- **Discuss and take action to pay bills for Pritchett VFD as submitted and approved**. Motion by Cloddie Henson and second by Bobby Jenkins to pay Pritchett VFD bills in the amount of \$6,993.56. Motion carried 5-0. Unanimous vote in favor.
- **22)** Discuss and take action to pay bills for Simpsonville VFD as submitted and approved. No bills submitted.
- 23) <u>Discuss and take action to pay bills for West Mountain VFD as submitted and approved</u>. Motion by Cloddie Henson and second by Scott Mischnick to pay West Mountain VFD bills in the amount of \$541.66. Motion carried 5-0. Unanimous vote in favor.
- **24)** Discuss and take action on any insurance claim pay outs to rural departments. Two checks were received from VFIS for claims paid for damages to West Mountain VFD. Kenny Southwell made a motion with a second by Scott Mischnick to deposit the checks in the amounts of \$20,470.56 and \$5,319.65 into the ESD checking account until further action. Motion carried 5-0. Unanimous vote in favor.
- **25)** Discuss and take action on any grant reimbursement requests submitted. Bettie VFD was awarded a PPE grant in the amount of \$20,000.00. Motion by Kenny Southwell with a second by Scott Mischnick to reimburse Bettie VFD in the amount of \$2,000.00 as 10% of the grant award. Motion carried 5-0. Unanimous vote in favor.

- **26)** Discuss and take action on any budget amendments. Motion by Kenny Southwell with a second by Scott Mischnick to move \$422.52 from retained earnings to radio maintenance to balance the overage in this line item. Motion carried 5-0. Unanimous vote in favor.
- 27) Items to be considered for next month's agenda. Items #7 and #9 (combine as 1 item) and #5, #6 and #8 (combine as 1 item)
